## \*\*\*Important Highlights\*\*\*

- Students are considered unvaccinated if their vaccination card has not been uploaded into the **COVID Vaccination Card Verification** system. Click link to upload
- Screen & Stay students CANNOT participate in before and after school activities. If asymptomatic, they can take a PCR test on the **8th day after exposure**, and if negative, results should be brought to the Nurse's Office. The student athlete can then return to sports on the **11th day after exposure**.
- Positive students will need to review and follow the <u>NPS Athletics COVID-19 Return</u> to <u>Play Protocols</u>
